A Mentoring Programme for Traditional Musicians in Scotland

Applications are now open for **TradMentor**, which offers traditional musicians mentoring from established practitioners. This programme is part of the Traditional Music Forum's ongoing support for artists working in traditional music in Scotland.

A mentoring partnership provides one-to-one time with a trained mentor to discuss your work in confidence. *You will decide what to focus on* and how to use the time. This is not only for early-career musicians, but also for experienced practitioners who would like to make time for reflection in a supported context. Previous mentees have said...

Mentee places are available for the programme, which will run from November 2020 to July 2021. Applicants should be:

- based in Scotland
- not in full-time education
- a member of the TMF, or associated with a TMF member organisation
- over 18
